Please take a photograph of your child reading in an unusual place for our new library display. It could be a photograph of them reading in the garden, the car, in a tent or even upside down - the more unusual the better! Please bring them into school by the end of next week for our display.

### EYFS and KS1 Reading Books

Reading books and library books will be given out this week. Reading at home is very important in supporting your child to apply and practice the skills they have been taught at school. Please make sure your child has a reading book in their book bag every day and HSLB comments are completed each week - thank you for your support.

### KS2 Reading Books

This week your child will complete a STAR reading assessment. This will give your child a new ZPD level so that they can choose the correct range of books for their reading ability. Each class has an additional weekly ICT slot for children to complete an AR quiz on the book once they have finished it. Children will be awarded with a certificate if they pass the reading quiz. Many of the children are reading lots at home so that they can read over 1 million words and join our 'Millionaires Club'.

You can check to see if a reading book from home has an AR quiz by searching on <http://www.arbookfind.co.uk/UserType.aspx> and typing in the book title. This will tell you the ZPD and the quiz number.

Please speak to your child's class teacher if you would like to find out more about supporting reading at home or volunteering to listen to other children read at school.

Can you please check at home for any old library books that have not been returned to school and if you have any books that you would like to donate to the children's library please bring them to the office where they will be gratefully received.
