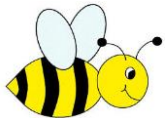
Head teacher Certificate

8:45- 8:55 am Morning Registration

The children need to be in school ready for the register to be taken at 8:55 am. The teachers will start to take the register at 8:55am and the first lesson of the day needs to start promptly after that.
