Our history topic this term is the Ancient Egyptians. Choose one of the following for your creative homework!



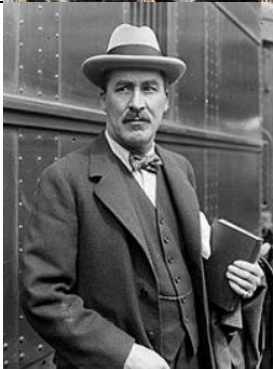
Get creative with your artistic skills! You could research Egyptian jewellery and then design and make your own piece; create a picture inspired by the pyramids or the River Nile; or design and make an Egyptian sarcophagus (coffin).



Research the stories, myths and legends of Ancient Egypt and then create your own story, perhaps involving the Egyptian gods and goddesses.



What kind of food did the Ancient Egyptians enjoy? Research Ancient Egyptian recipes and have a go at making a dish or even a full meal. Take photos of your creation and write a set of instructions so that others can have a go too!



The tomb of Tutankhamun was discovered by Howard Carter almost 100 years ago. Imagine stepping into the tomb and discovering the most amazing treasures! Find out more about Howard Carter's exploits and then create a newspaper report about the discovery; write a diary entry by Howard recording what happened and how he felt; or create a map of the pharaoh's tomb and a set of instructions explaining how to navigate any traps and pitfalls that await the unwary explorer.



What facts can you discover about Ancient Egypt? Once you have done your research, find an interesting way to present your findings. You could create a booklet, make a Powerpoint or even make a board game!
