Homework

- ▶ Children will be given creative homework each half term. This half term, creative homework links to our topic 'Darwin's Delights.'
- ▶ Children will have 10 to 14 spellings to learn each week and will also be asked to practise words from the statutory word lists.
- ▶ Children are also expected to independently practise their times tables (using TT Rockstars) so that they become increasingly fluent.
- ▶ Read, read, read!
- ▶ Other homework will vary. Sometimes, children will be asked to review papers at home that they have taken in class. Reading comprehensions will also be regularly completed.

- ▶ Spelling patterns up to Christmas (see website).
- ▶ Then the statutory Year 5/6 word list (in HSLB).
- ▶ Then homophones and revision of KS2 spelling patterns.

KS2 SATs Dates 2020 – Testing Period

Monday May 11th 2020: Spelling, punctuation and grammar Test- Grammar/Punctuation- 45 minutes

Tuesday May 12th 2020: Reading Test- 60 minutes
