



Yealmpton Primary School Modern Foreign Languages - Schemes of Work

At Yealmpton Primary School children develop their understanding of the French language through the following course of study. This mirrors the scheme of work developed by Twinkl, in line with the aims of the new National Curriculum. Learning another language gives children a new perspective on the world, encouraging them to understand their own cultures and those of others. It extends their knowledge of how language works and helps them to develop communication skills, including the key skills of speaking and listening. Each of the four main learning aims and the twelve content points for the Key Stage 2 National Curriculum for Languages are revisited throughout the four-year scheme, ensuring that pupils have every opportunity to make progress in their:

- knowledge about language
- language-learning strategies
- functional knowledge and use of grammar and spelling
- intercultural understanding
- speaking, listening, reading and writing skills
