Homework

- Children will be given creative homework options each half term. This half term, creative homework links to our geography topic.
- Parents will be invited to an exhibition of the children's homework towards the end of each half term.
- Children will have 10 to 14 spellings to learn each week.
- Children are also expected to independently practise their times tables (using TT Rockstars) so that they become increasingly fluent.
- Read, read, read!
- Other homework will vary. Sometimes, children will be asked to review papers at home that they have taken in class. Reading comprehensions will also be regularly completed.
