SUMMER TERM 2018 OAK CLASS

<p>ENGLISH</p> <p>We will begin by creating stories inspired by Ted Hughes' <i>How the Whale Became</i>, writing our own tales to explain how an animal of our choosing acquired its distinctive feature. We will also be writing biographies and autobiographies.</p> <p>After half term, we will use Shackleton's <i>Journey</i> as a stimulus for writing our own recounts about memorable moments from our own lives. Finally, we will develop our ability to write balanced arguments.</p> <p>In the build-up to SATS, we will continue to develop our understanding of spelling, punctuation and grammar. We will also be practising our reading comprehension skills.</p>	<p>MATHEMATICS</p> <p>Up until SATS, we will continue to go through practice papers as well as revising key topics from across Key Stage 2.</p> <p>Once SATS have been completed, we will be undertaking a range of maths-based projects that give the children the opportunity to apply their learning in different contexts.</p>
<p>SCIENCE</p> <p>This term, the children will be learning about aspects of evolution, including adaptation; how changes in the environment affect living things; and classification.</p>	<p>GEOGRAPHY</p> <p>We will be learning about international trade, with a particular focus on the hosts of the 2014 and 2018 FIFA World Cups, Brazil and Russia. We will also be learning about Fairtrade.</p>
<p>COMPUTING</p> <p>In computing, the children will be learning how to create a blog with a particular focus on e-safety, sharing information with visitors to the school website on how to stay safe online.</p>	<p>ART and DT</p> <p>In art, we will be considering what makes an effective flag before making our own Fairtrade flags. We will be designing a seasonal salad in DT.</p>
<p>MUSIC</p> <p>Our music this term will be taught by a specialist from Ivybridge Community College, Mr Rodgers.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>We will be considering the question: Does belief in life after death help Muslims to live a good life?</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>Ms Kee will be teaching athletics while Mr Hardman will be teaching rounders and helping the children prepare for Sports Day.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE this term, we will be focusing on Wellbeing.</p>
