PRIMARY SCHOOL

Read Write Inc.

- Reading is essential!
- In EYFS, KSI (and LKS2) children will be taught to read using the high quality systematic synthetic phonics programme Read Write Inc. (RWI)
- Children are taught consistently to use phonics as the route to reading unknown words. At this stage, we introduce the opportunity for pupils to have sufficient practice in reading and re-reading books that match their progress level both at home and in school.

Read, read, read!

Reading books that will be sent home:

- · A Read Write Inc book from current group.
- · A Read Write Inc book from previous book colour to build fluency.
- · Read Write Inc storybook assigned online on Oxford Owl. Oxford Oxford
- · A library (picture book) to be shared together at home.

Read, read, read!



· When your child comes to the end of the Read Write Inc programme, they will move on to Accelerated Reader (AR) books. Children will complete a reading test which will give an AR level. Children pick their book at their level from the school library. When children have read their books and feel confident to answer questions about the plot, characters and their likes/dislikes, they take an AR quiz. The quiz will give the child the next AR level to take - it can move up, down or stay the same.

- ·Children will have 10 spellings to learn each week and some form of Maths challenge that will usually link to our learning in class.
- · Read, read! Please make comments in the children's Home School Link Book.
- · Children have access to Numbots and in the Spring Term will have access to TT Rockstars.
